THE HAVANA TOWER AT THE QUARTER AT TROPICANA

ATLANTIC CITY, NJ – **The Quarter at Tropicana Casino and Resort** holds bragging rights to one of the largest non-gaming expansion in the history of the city. One of the project's key features is **The Havana Tower**, an 18-floor hotel, consisting of 505 new guest rooms, 45,000 square feet of hospitality suites and meeting space with stunning, unobstructed ocean to bay views, as well as 2,400 new parking spaces. When combined with the existing property, Tropicana is the largest hotel in the state of New Jersey.

"The Havana Tower allows us to accommodate all of the new visitors to The Quarter and Tropicana," said **Mark Giannantonio**, president and chief executive officer of Tropicana Casino and Resort. "We've factored in all of the latest state-of-the-art amenities, lavish facilities and services at the Havana Tower."

The Havana Tower's guest rooms measure 374 square feet, and are equipped with a refrigerator, coffee maker, safe, iron and ironing board, hair dryer, high speed internet access, two phone lines and 25" televisions. Each of the 34 premium suites measure 663 square feet and feature all of the amenities of the standard rooms, plus living rooms with sofas and chairs and an additional 25" television.

On the 18th floor, The Havana Tower features four Apex Board Rooms, measuring 780 square feet. Each board room offers: seating for up to 14; high speed internet access; striking views of the ocean and city; board room tables with built-in audio and video controls; recessed ceiling mounted video projectors and screens; high-tech audio and video systems; and video and teleconferencing equipment.

Four Summit Hospitality Suites, each 1,130 square feet, offer guests: high speed internet; incredible views; state-of-the-art audio and video systems; 42" high definition plasma televisions; wet bar; refrigerator; two seating areas with sofas and chairs; and dining area with six seats. The 28th floor houses a modern butler pantry to service the hospitality and boardroom suites.

In addition to building the largest hotel in the region, Tropicana's expansion project features The Quarter at Tropicana, which brings to life the streets of Old Havana through a sprawling two-story streetscape, offering guests more than 60 different dining, shopping, entertainment and spa options. The Quarter and Tropicana provides visitors with more than 18 restaurants, capable of accommodating more than 5,000 diners, while offering three times the entertainment, shopping and spa options than any other hotel casino in Atlantic City.
